1. New Members pay full VMAA / MAAA fee if joining 1 July – Dec 31. New Members pay half year after 31st Dec.
2. VARMS joining fee is applicable to all those who have not been a VARMS member during the previous 12 months
3. Applicants with previous VMAA / MAAA affiliation, and / or VARMS membership are requested to provide their registration numbers as applicable.
4. Pensioners are required to give their CRN number in the space given on the membership annual fee form.
5. VMAA / MAAA Insurance provides all members with public liability cover and includes personal accident cover for members aged 10 to 90 years.
6. Full Time Student is defined as 18 – 25 years, as at July 1st and attending a secondary or tertiary institution on a full time basis. Proof of attendance is required.

***VARMS / MAAA / VMAA Pilot Ratings** - VARMS are maintaining a register of all member Wings ratings. You may be asked to provide a copy of your Wings certificate(s) and/or your MAAA affiliate badge to confirm your claimed Wings ratings. These copies will be held by VARMS to avoid a request for copies at each membership renewal.

Bronze Wings - Approved Policy

1. Bronze Wings must be held by all those VARMS members flying solo at Briggs Field.
2. VARMS will satisfy itself that member claims of holding Bronze Wings are valid. This will be done by VARMS having conducted the test or having sighted and retained a copy of the member Bronze Wings or higher level test certificate and/or the MAAA affiliate card showing the Wings rating claimed.
3. Solo pilots of gliders will require Bronze Wings Glider or Power Bronze Wings rating as a minimum. This VARMS policy recognises that the Bronze Wings Power test assessment covers all the competencies needed to safely fly a glider plus other power specific tests.
4. Solo pilots of power models will require Bronze Wings Power rating as a minimum.
5. Solo pilots of helicopters will require Bronze Wings Heli rating as a minimum.
6. VARMS will continue to offer a “solo” test for electric gliders. This test is offered as a supplement to holders of Bronze Wings Glider. It is not mandatory, but is recommended.
7. Where the MAAA has set a minimum Wings Rating for specific types of model flying, such as for Heavy models, these will continue to apply, without exception, for flying at Briggs Field
8. Current and prospective members, who are not approved to fly their type of model at Briggs Field, are required to secure a current member of VARMS as their “buddy” to stand by them at all times, whilst flying at Briggs Field. The “buddy” is to be available to them to assist with setting up and confirming the safety of their equipment, model and adherence to the rules of Briggs Field. This “buddy” must hold Bronze or Gold Wings for the type of model being flown.
